## FROM THE DIVISION OF FISHERIES & WILDLIFE

Sign up for a Basic Hunter Education Course now. Students who successfully pass a course will receive a Certificate of Completion that is acceptable for purchasing a Massachusetts hunting or sporting license. It also allows students 15 years or older to apply for a firearms license at their local police departments. These Certificates of Completion are also recognized in all the United States, Canada and Mexico for the purchase of a hunting or sporting license. Basic courses for the beginning of 2010 are posted at: [www.mass.gov/dfwele/dfw/education/hed\\_course\\_schedule.htm](http://www.mass.gov/dfwele/dfw/education/hed_course_schedule.htm). Some 1,800 retired brood-stock salmon from the Connecticut River Atlantic Salmon Restoration Program were released by the Division into lakes and ponds across the State in December. Another 100 salmon will be stocked in early January. A list of the waters stocked with these huge fish is now posted at [www.mass.gov/masswildlife](http://www.mass.gov/masswildlife). Some of these salmon weigh 18 pounds.

## WINTER RIFLE MATCHES
