### MASS WILDLIFE CENTRAL DISTRICT TROUT STOCKING

"CENTRAL District trout stocking is in high gear with virtually all ponds and lakes having been stocked at least once. Exceptions are flooded impoundments where water is being held in response to the heavy rains of late March. Major rivers have been stocked and smaller streams are being scheduled as water levels recede. The majority of the fish released have been rainbow trout in the 12 - 14+ inch range raised at the McLaughlin Hatchery. Trucks will be heading to the other hatcheries shortly to add brook, brown and tiger trout to central Massachusetts waters. Weekly stocking updates will be posted every Friday on the MassWildlife.org website and will be available by calling the District office at (508) 835-3607 Ext 13."
