D-Day RIFLE MATCH!!

We're doing a Vintage Service Rifle Match on June 6th. It'll be any WWII battle rifle with "sustained" fire. That's 40 shots in 5 minutes at 100 yards on SR-1 targets. It's like 4 rapid fires in a row and you can shoot from any standard position you like best - Prone, sitting, kneeling or off-hand. The cost is \$5.00. The first relay starts at 10 AM. You'll need your WWII battle rifle and 40 rounds of ammo in clips or magazines. You can shoot Garand's, M-1 Carbines, 03 Springfield's, SMLE's, Mauser's, Nagants, Carcano's, etc. Any military rifle that was used in World War II. Slings are OK, but no scopes, no sighters. Though it's a fun shoot, we'd like to remember the Brave Men who carried these rifles while fighting for freedom. Instead of prizes, we will be donating the proceeds to the Leominster WWII/Korean War Memorial Fund.
