If you're target shooting on Saturday afternoon, keep an eye out for errant hunters.

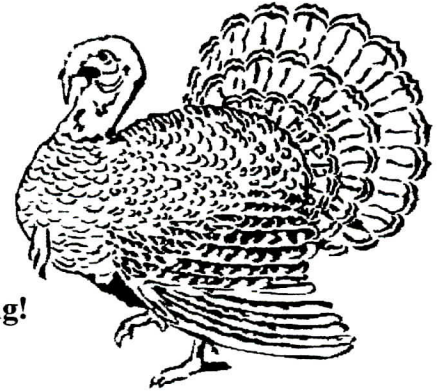
While the rifle range is closed to target shooting, it is not closed to hunting. You may hunt on and around the range until noon.

Anglers, birders, hunters, trappers, hikers, naturalist and boaters are asked to voice their recreational needs by filling out a statewide recreational survey. The Division on Conservation Services (DCS) is encouraging Mass. Residents to fill out an important survey that will help guide decisions on how state funding can be best used for the acquisition of conservation or park land. The deadline for completing the survey is October 31<sup>st</sup>. Note from the Secretary: The people who don't hunt or fish will fill out this survey. They will get the bulk of the State money unless YOU take a few minutes and take the survey!
