-Must take a Range Officer/safety course given by Mike Fontaine and A.J. Tourigny... Includes:

- Learn and understand range etiquette.
 - Learn and understand range safety and dealing with firearm malfunctions.
 - Learn and understand how to call a standard NRA National Match Course
 - Take a written test.
 - Must be able to shoot 10 shots off the bench (two hands will be permitted) on a NRA approved 50 foot target with all 10 shots in the scoring rings. Individual must provide their own target, pistol, and ammunition.

Range Times

- Thursday nights from 7pm-8pm (open hours)
